



MINDCARE NEW BRUNSWICK RESEARCH GRANT

MAXIMUM AMOUNT: up to \$20,000 (non-renewable)

PURPOSE: This grant is intended to support research on mental health issues in the province of New Brunswick. Relevant topics include research concerning the prevention of mental illness, early detection of mental health difficulties, assessment/diagnosis, and treatment. Research attempting to create a better understanding of factors relevant to the development, course, and manifestation of mental illness will also be considered.

ELIGIBILITY: Professionals or academics with an interest in mental health, who currently live and work/study in New Brunswick, are invited to apply. All applications must include a research consultant as a member of the research team. This consultant must have a faculty appointment at a recognized university, but does not have to be the principle investigator nor a resident of New Brunswick. Special consideration will be given to young scholars (no more than 6 years post-graduate degree), student research at the Honours or Graduate level, and applications from people working in the field of mental health. In addition, applicants must identify an expert in the field of the proposed research who is not affiliated with the proposal, to whom MindCare may send the application for review if deemed necessary.

The successful candidate(s) will be expected to present their research findings to the MindCare Committee in Saint John, New Brunswick, within 2 years after the grant has been awarded. Successful applicants will also be required to submit an annual progress report. Please note, funds will not be released until REB approval has been obtained.
